Library People is a statewide, not-for-profit organization dedicated to helping libraries with library collections, services and programs through grants, technical assistance, connections, and advocacy.

Current projects include:

- Advocacy on behalf of libraries to involve Coloradans in supporting their institutions.
- Grants and technical advice for Colorado's libraries, especially rural and smaller libraries.
- Activities to benefit the community at large, such as marketing, public relations, and commemorations.
- Support for Colorado's local Friends groups.

Our mission: Libraries provide education, information and cultural enrichment for all people. Library People, a nonprofit organization, works toward quality library service for Colorado residents by providing advocacy, support, and coordination of service projects to enable libraries of all types, especially small and rural libraries, to meet community needs.

Members of the Board of Directors are integral to plan and implement policies and activities to reach these ends. We are especially interested in reaching individuals who represent the diversity of the state in terms of geography, library size, gender, ethnicity, and personal background.

General responsibilities of Board members are:

1. Attend quarterly meetings regularly. Attendance via telephone or electronically is acceptable.
2. Support for the organization's activities through personal financial commitment and assistance to other fundraising efforts.
3. Make policy and provide leadership.
4. Commitment to involvement each year in a project or activity. Examples include organizing an event, serving as a liaison with local Friends' contacts, preparing communications materials, writing grants, organizing advocacy plans, or other similar pursuit.
